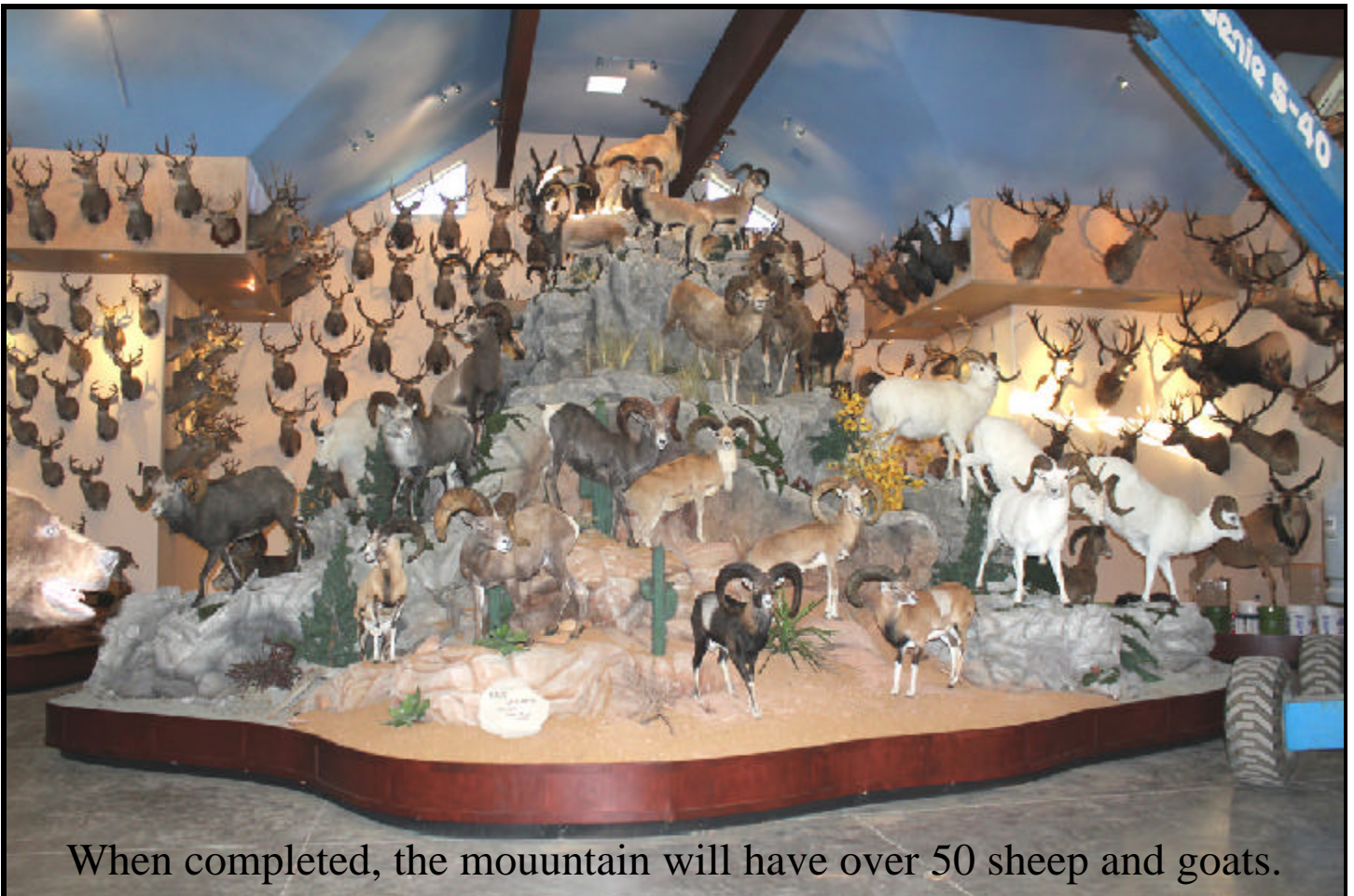
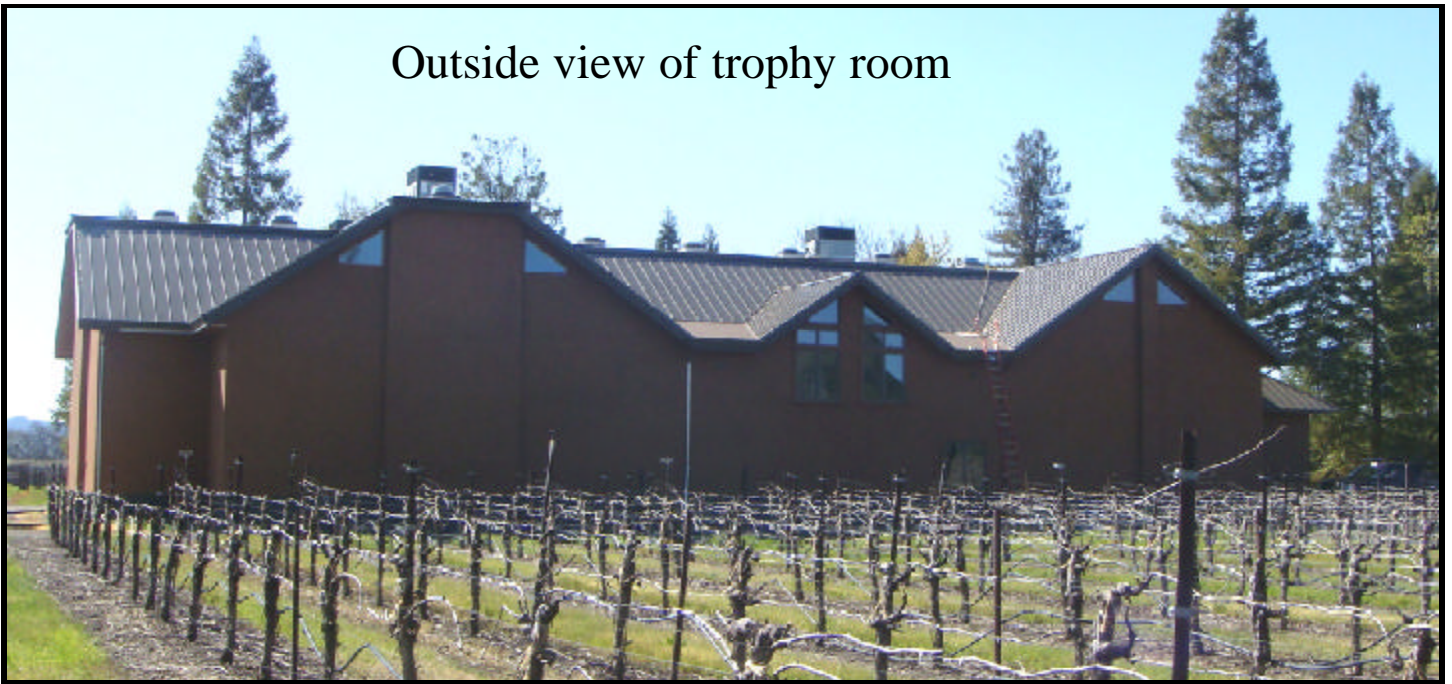


Update: Ken Barr Trophy Room.

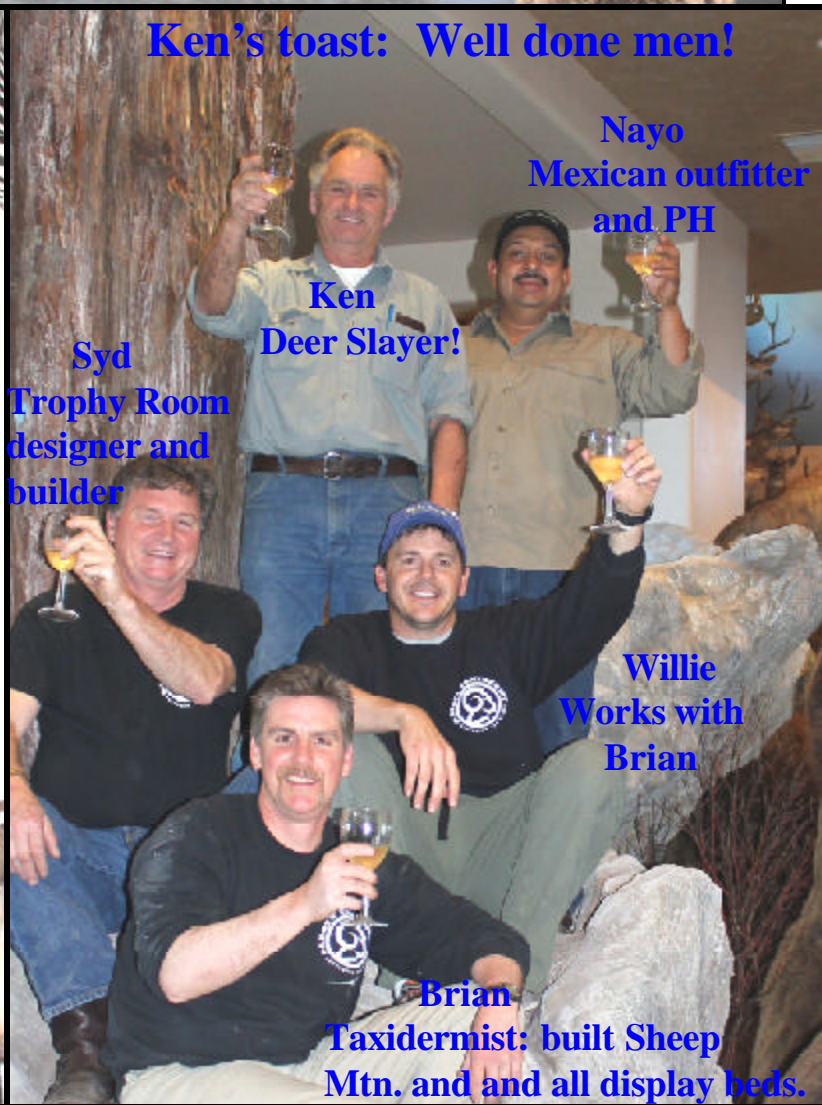


Silly Goose!
